
Life-cycle Wheel Directions:



Materials: 12 in. \times 9 in. construction paper, circle cut-out about 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches, brad or paper fastener, colored pencils, markers, or crayons

1. Fold the construction paper in half. Cut a window on the top page of the construction paper. Vary the size and shape of the window to fit different animal life cycles.



- 2. Cut out the circle. Divide the circle into 4 equal parts with a light pencil line. Place the circle on the right side of the folded construction paper so that the edge of the circle protrudes slightly from the edge of the page.
- 3. Place the brad through the center of the circle and the construction paper.
- 4. Glue or draw the life cycle of a plant or animal (one picture in each quarter of the circle).
